SUMMER TERM CCF UPDATE

Another busy term is ahead of us in the CCF. Our recruits will make their final steps towards qualifying as Cadets, and our existing cadets will be undergoing advanced training. **Please find below a list of key training dates.**

The start of a new term provides an opportunity to remind all cadets and parents of a few points:

1. **Regular Attendance** - In order to ensure that training runs smoothly, regular attendance **every Wednesday** evening from **1915 hrs to 2115 hrs** is expected. Permission to be excused from a parade evening can be requested in advance. Please telephone/email the CCF direct.
2. **Turnout** - Smart uniform and appearance are part of being a cadet. Uniform must be washed and pressed. Boots must be clean and well polished.
Hair on boys will be short, above the collar and with full face showing. Girls will be required to tie long hair back in a bun.
Cadets will not be allowed to participate unless they meet these conditions.
3. **Annual General Inspection (AGI) – Sunday 8 May 2011** - A very important event in the CCF calendar. 2011 marks the 70th Anniversary of the formation of a Cadet Force at Caterham. **This is a compulsory event for all cadets.**
An invite letter is at the bottom of this update, along with detailed timings for cadets. If, due to extenuating circumstances, your son/daughter cannot attend please email the CCF at the above email address.
4. **Contingent Range & Training Day** - We will be running a range day for qualified cadets (if unsure, ask) on Sunday 19 June 2011.
5. **Army Section Field Day** – There will be a fieldcraft training exercise added to the Contingent Training Day for the **Army Section only**. This will be Monday 20 June 2011.
6. **Gibraltar Summer Camp Briefing** – **Attendance at this briefing is MANDATORY** for all cadets going on this camp. It will take place on **Wednesday 22 June at 1845 hrs**. Parents are welcome to attend should they wish. More details relating to the camp to follow.

7. **Gibraltar Summer Camp – 16-24 July 2011** – We have 55 cadets and officers going to Gibraltar. More details will follow in due course. Please note Briefing date.
8. **RAF Section Field Day (AEF)** – Details for RAF Section cadets to go flying will be supplied to those wishing to go.

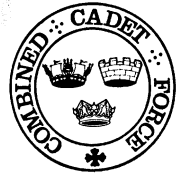

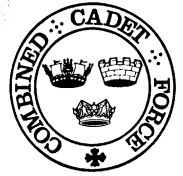

Sunday 8 May 2011 – Annual General Inspection (AGI) Timings for Cadets

Your son or daughter will need to be at school for most of the day. The exact timings are shown below.

Arrive: 0830 hrs	All Cadets, in Uniform (except Guard of Honour)
Depart: 1100 hrs	All Cadets (except Guard of Honour)
Depart: 1200 hrs	Guard of Honour (except Door Guard x 2)
Arrive: 1345 hrs	All Cadets
Depart: 1730 hrs earliest	All Cadets

Please note that Cadets will not be released by the Contingent Officers until all equipment has been returned to Stores and all chairs have been returned to classrooms.

Cadets will not be joining you for tea.
