Definitions:

Chemist:

'A member of the Royal Pharmaceutical Society, engaged in selling or dispensing medicines direct to the public. The term includes persons who are unemployed by reasons of bankruptcy, corporate insolvency or redundancy and who fell within the descriptions at the time their employment ceased'.

Commercial Travellers

'The representative, agent or principal of any firm of manufacturers, industrial or commercial firm or company, or wholesale dealers selling to industry or commerce, but not direct to the public, who has travelled for five consecutive years and, in the aggregate, for at least six months in each of those years, for the purpose of securing orders and/or promoting business. The term includes persons who are unemployed by reason of bankruptcy, corporate insolvency or redundancy and who fell within the definition at the time their employment ceased'.

Grocers

'A person engaged or employed in the business of selling by retail a wide range of goods, whether edible or not, used in household provision and management excluding persons owning or employed by a business having more than fifty employees. The term includes persons who are unemployed by reason of bankruptcy, corporate insolvency or redundancy and who fell within the description at the time their engagement or employment ceased'.
