German Study Visit: 11 April 2011 - 15 April 2011

I am writing to inform you of an opportunity for your son or daughter to take part in a study visit to the beautiful city of Heidelberg in the state of Baden Wurttemberg for 5 days during the Easter holidays of 2011. This trip is open to all those pupils in the First and Second year who are currently learning German. We have been organising a similar trip for several years now and it has always been tremendously enjoyed by the pupils.

We have researched various possibilities and are pleased to tell you that we can offer you a very worthwhile trip at a reasonable price. This kind of opportunity provides an excellent way to practise German listening and speaking and to discover a different way of life. Excursion highlights will include a trip to the Europa Park theme park and visits around the city of Heidelberg itself, taking in the magnificent castle, town hall and market square and even visiting the student prison.

Evening activities will probably involve bowling and a disco and will be teacher accompanied. There will also almost certainly be a trip to an authentic German Eiscafe. Costs are hard to predict exactly, but we shall be endeavouring to keep the total basic cost to about £400. This will include:

- Meals on a half board basis.
- Excursions and entrance fees.
- Packed lunches.
- Evening activities.
