Dear Parents and Guardians,

As you may be aware, this term all the Fourth Year pupils at Caterham School study 'Macbeth' as part of their IGCSE English Literature course. By a happy coincidence, there is a production of 'Macbeth' at the Globe Theatre on the evening of Friday 11 March. We think that seeing this production will be a very enjoyable way of rounding off our study of the play and we would hope that as many pupils as possible will be able to avail themselves of this opportunity. Unfortunately, 11 March is also the evening of the House Drama Competition and any pupil involved in this competition cannot be included in the Globe Theatre visit. This is a special short run of 'Macbeth' and the only tickets available are standing ones. The production lasts one hour forty minutes without an interval, so pupils need to bear this in mind before deciding whether they would like to go. It looks as if it is going to be a fast-paced, interesting, modern-dress production and well worth seeing.

The coaches will leave Caterham School at 5.15pm and should arrive back at School between 10.15pm and 10.30pm. For pupils who will not have time to go home to eat before the coaches leave, supper will be provided at school at 4.45pm. Pupils will be able to change into their own clothes for the trip but they should make sure they have warm outdoor clothing which is waterproof and which has a hood in case of rain.

The tickets are free because the production is sponsored by the Deutsche Bank, the coach fare is £9 and supper has been arranged at a cost of £2. The over-all cost will be added to the school bill. Please let me know if you would prefer to make alternative arrangements for payment.
