Re: Sixth Form Facilities Charge

One of the School's objectives with the very senior members of the School's student community is to encourage their sense of responsibility and care for property. The School has taken great care and attention to provide superb facilities for our Sixth Form. With this in mind we introduced a 'facilities charge' on all members of the Sixth Form over six years ago and this has been maintained ever since.

We levy the annual 'facilities charge' of £12 for each student every year whilst they are in the Sixth Form. The money is held in a fund which is used to replace lost or damaged equipment – not resulting from usual wear and tear - in the Sixth Form area. The aim is to encourage Sixth Form students to take communal responsibility for their area.

We will 'levy' this charge on the forthcoming termly bill and in the following September bill.
