Young First Aider

The St Johns Ambulance are running a 'Young First Aider' First Aid Course for the Third Year on both Monday 4 or Tuesday 5 July 2011; which day your child takes part will depend on when he or she is going to Canterbury.

If your child has any injuries or is unable to take part in any of the physical activities involved they should notify the St John's Ambulance Trainer or the member of staff supervising the activity. Please also be advised that students should wear sensible clothes which will allow them to move about freely. When they have completed the day course each participant will receive a certificate which can then be used in the future for both the Duke of Edinburgh Award Scheme and for CCF activities as well as being an extremely useful 'life skill'.

The course is subsidised but there will be a small fee of £8.50 per pupil which will be added onto the end of term bill. Should you not wish your child to participate in this activity please return the slip below by Friday 24 June otherwise I will assume that you are happy for your child to take part in this very worthwhile course.
