The PE department are organising a trip to watch the England V New Zealand netball test match, which is on Wednesday 19 January, 7pm, at the O2 arena.

New Zealand are the current Commonwealth Games champions, after they defeated the World Number One ranked team, Australia, in the Final. England finished in the bronze medal position. With netball traditionally being dominated by the Southern Hemisphere teams, over the last few years England have proven that they can now compete alongside the best in the world. In 2009 England lost to New Zealand by just six goals, and in 2010 England beat Australia for the first time in twenty nine years. This latest test series against New Zealand is certain to be extremely closely fought.

It is a superb opportunity for the girls to watch netball played at this level and they should be able to learn a great deal and be inspired to train hard and improve their own game.

We will travel by minibus and we will leave School at 5pm and then return back to School at approximately 9.30pm. The cost of the trip will be £16, which includes the ticket for the match and transport. We will also arrange for the girls to have a packed tea as we travel to the venue.
