Five artists visited Caterham School last week to run workshops for the 5th Year students who are studying art.

The pupils had a very stimulating day as each artist worked with about 10 pupils talking about their approach and showing them examples of their art. Pupils then produced their own work based on the practice of that artist.



Headmaster Rob Davey said: "Although the school has a reputation for excellent results in Maths and the Sciences we are also very strong in Art & Design. For instance all GCSE passes were at grades A*-B. These visits by contemporary, practising artists are another example of the innovative ways in which we help the pupils develop a broad understanding of the subject."

Christy Symington, a London based sculptor who has exhibited extensively both in the UK and internationally. Carolyn Genders, a Sussex based ceramicist who exhibits widely. Ali Tareen, a London based graphics/fine artist. Ashley Portland, a former pupil who is now a London based film maker currently running the Etio project.
