On Monday 2 October we welcomed ten parents and Old Caterhamiams to the School, to talk about their career paths so far. Old Cat, Todd Styles talked about his accountancy apprenticeship and how he knows he made the right decision not to go to university, choosing to study and work in order to avoid pupil debt. We also had talks on ship broking, tax consultancy, management consultancy, life as a barrister in specialisms such as family and financial law, the legal profession, actuarial science and human resources. UCAS

We are pleased to report that 63 applications, which include 51 early applications (Oxbridge, Medics, Dentists and Vets) have been submitted to UCAS so far. 54 Offers have already been received, an encouraging position for this stage of the cycle.

We would like to encourage all pupils who have yet to submit their applications to do so in the next week. The School require some time to check and process these before they are finally sent to UCAS.

Overseas University Applications

Twenty pupils are applying to universities in Hong Kong, Australia, America and Canada this year.

Hong Kong Universities

Early application deadlines for Hong Kong universities are fast approaching and documents must be submitted by 15 November, please. Regular applications are to be submitted by 5 January in most cases. Please remember that Mrs Brown does not work over the Christmas break so any online references need to be requested by 5 December!
