Caterham School reach the National Final of British Schools Karting Championship

A team of three Caterham School students have won a place in the National Final of the British Schools Karting Championship (BSKC). They will compete against the best 32 school and college teams in the country at Whilton Mill on 19 July. Mrs Charlotte Bell, who runs the Caterham School Karting Team, said: 'Once again the standard of competition has been very high so I was delighted for the team that they managed to achieve a place in the national finals, coming 3rd out of 25 schools in the South East Region Finals. They then displayed considerable maturity as they managed to hold off their rivals to finish with a consistently strong set of results.'
