Task 1:

 - BBC
 - The Economist
 - The FT
- For each article, write a brief summary and include in it any concepts or key terms that were new to you or questions you had.

Task 2:

- Start reading one of the below introductory titles. They are all available on Amazon and shops, and many can be found in charity shops as some have been around a while. They are all written in a very engaging way and are great starter texts. This is an ongoing task and we do not expect it to be finished in a couple of days, but get hold of a copy and get started!
